The POEME partnership has not stopped working to achieve the project's goals, and there is a lot of news to share. In the past 6 months, we have worked on the POEME e-books, produced an Interactive e-Guidebook for the POEME exhibitions and started working on the last Intellectual Output of the project: the POEME blended exhibitions.

#### THE POEME E-BOOKS

Each partner developed two e-books focused on an element of the cultural heritage of the countries of the partnership. The e-books are an evolution of the e-worksheets created in the project and are aimed at second language acquisition. The e-books are interactive and include audio voice-overs and a glossary with the definition of difficult words that appear in the stories. Each book is available in three difficulty levels (A1, A2 and B1) and has been translated into French, Portuguese and Greek.

E-books can also be used to facilitate and enhance student learning.

The fourth Intellectual Output of the POEME project is now available on the project's website. The POEME interactive e-Guidebook provides a step-by-step process for creating blended exhibitions that effectively engage students and enhance their learning experience.
